

I Didn't Know That

- Visitors to our parish website come from some 27 countries. Most visitors come from the USA, France, Canada, Italy and the UK.
- Church Bells are named after Angels. Our large bell (600 lbs) Archangel Uriel; the middle bell (300 lbs) Archangel Salaphiel and the small bell (225 lbs), Archangel Jegudiel.
- Of the 52 parishes in the NY-NJ Diocese, there are 29 parishes smaller than us and 26 parishes, larger than us (census of 77).
- Every altar must have a relic of a martyr saint. Local tradition is that our altar has a relic of Great-Martyr Barbara.
- One can make the Sign of the Cross: upon the heads of children as they leave for school; when one is about to take medicine; when tempted; when hearing good/bad news; when about to do spiritual reading.
