Meditation

True freedom is with God who alone can liberate us from the bondage of our own will given to sinful inclinations and ways. "Where the Spirit of the Lord is present, there is freedom" (2 Cor. 3:17). True freedom is with Christ whose saving truths set us free. "If the Son sets you free, then you will be really free" (Jn 8:36).
